The original store was then rented to Dottie and Rick Roderick who reopened it as the Red Parka Pub. The Rodericks then moved away and in 1972 the Grants leased the building to Jean and Dewey Mark and Al and Lois Nelson. When Tony Ferruolo joined in the partnership and bought the Nelson's share, the journey continued through the years as a very successful business and the place to go for apres ski and a good steak. Today, Terry O'Brien (daughter of Jean and Dewey Mark) and her mother Jean Melczarek (formerly Mark) are the sole owners of the Pub.
