ELECTIONEERING ORDINANCE

The following ordinance was approved at the March 10, 1987 Town Meeting:

ARTICLE 35. To see if the Town will vote to eliminate all electioneering or signature gathering on Town or School owned property at any meetings or elections held within the Town of Bartlett. This authority was given to the Town under NH RSA 31:41-c.

Article 35. Electioneering. Towns shall have the power to make bylaws regulating the distribution of campaign materials or electioneering or any activity which affects the safety, welfare and rights of voters at any election held for any purpose in such town. Such power shall not extend to the display of printed or written matter attached to any legally parked motor vehicle, nor shall such power extend to activities conducted wholly on private property so as not to interfere with people approaching or entering a polling place. Failure to conform to bylaws adopted under this section shall constitute a violation. Bylaws adopted under this section may be posted 72 hours in advance of any town election, at the town clerk's office.
