Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen will be holding a public hearing as noticed above on the 2020 Town Budget and Warrant Articles for the March Town Meeting. Copies of the budget and warrant articles will be available at the meeting. The public is invited to attend.

**BOND HEARINGS:**

1) Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen will be holding a public hearing as noticed above on the Warrant Article for the March Town Meeting as follows:

**ARTICLE** . To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$500,000.00 for the purpose of town road improvements to authorize the issuance of not more than \$300,000.00 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes for up to five years and to determine the rate of interest thereon, with any balance to be raised by taxation. (2/3 majority vote by ballot required)

2) Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen will be holding a public hearing as noticed above on the Warrant Article for the March Town Meeting as follows:

**ARTICLE** . To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$600,000.00 for the purpose of flood damage repair to the Saco and Rocky Branch Rivers in the event the town is unable to obtain funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and/or USDA Natural Resources and Conservation Service and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$600,000.00 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33), and to authorize the Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes for up to five years and to determine the rate of interest thereon, with any balance to be raised by taxation. (2/3 majority vote by ballot required)

3) Notice is hereby given that the Board of Selectmen will be holding a public hearing as noticed above on the Warrant Article for the March Town Meeting as follows:

**ARTICLE** . To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$200,000.00 for additional flood damage repairs not covered by FEMA and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$200,000.00 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes for up to five years and to determine the rate of interest thereon, with any additional balance to be raised by taxation. The total estimated additional costs of repairs not covered by FEMA is \$200,000.00 (2/3 majority vote by ballot required). Agreeable to a petition signed by William Fabrizio and others.
