Office of Selectmen  
Meeting Minutes  
Wednesday, June 9, 2021

Attendees: Chairman Gene Chandler, Selectman Vicki Garland, Selectman August Vincent

Meeting opened at 4:28 p.m.

Chairman Chandler asked if everyone was ok with approving the minutes of 6/2/21. GGC – yes, VLG – yes, ADV – yes

Roger Labbe attended the meeting to ask questions regarding his access to the scrap metal at the transfer station to determine whether or not he wanted to renew his contract with the Towns of Bartlett and Jackson. The new contract increases his payment to the towns from \$1,250.00 per year to \$1,500.00 per year and requires Mr. Labbe to provide proof of liability insurance. After discussion, Mr. Labbe will renew the contract and provide a copy of the insurance binder to the Bartlett Selectmen on Thursday, 6/10/2021.

Chairman Chandler told Mr. Labbe that the Town of Bartlett has accepted his offer to purchase the scrap iron and culverts at the town garage for \$100.00.

Selectman Garland reported that the Bartlett Recreation Dept will resume the Concerts in the Park on Wednesdays in July. Rec. Director Annette Libby was inquiring if she would be able to have a concession stand again for these concerts. The Selectmen agreed she can offer concessions. Director Libby has also been told that the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade and concerts are both outdoor events and masks will not be required. The Selectman all agreed that despite there being no gathering after the parade this year, the parade route should remain the same.

Police Chief Keaton reported that Christopher Spinney did not appear for his court date on Tuesday, June 8, 2021. There is now an electronic bench warrant for his arrest with bail set at \$5000.00.

Chief Keaton also updated the Selectmen on his efforts to hire a new police officer to replace Richard Laferriere, who resigned in May. The Chief has received some applications and will be setting up an agility testing day and will keep the board updated on potential candidates.

Chairman Chandler told Chief Keaton that Angela Huertas attended the June 2, 2021 Selectman's meeting to discuss the issue of speeders on River Street and Cobb Farm Road. Chief Keaton will continue the department's directed patrols on these roads and will issue tickets to anyone caught speeding. Chairman Chandler will check with Road Agent Chick to see if we have any 30 mph speed limit signs to place an additional sign on Cobb Farm Road.

Chairman Chandler asked Chief Keaton if he had heard anymore from the NH DOT regarding the No Parking signs for Hurricane Mtn Rd and West Side Rd. Chief Keaton will follow up again this week with the NH DOT as he has not heard back from them.

Chief Keaton reported that he will be meeting with the manager of Walmart in North Conway to accept their donation and have a picture taken for the newspaper.

A new compactor container is needed for the Bartlett Jackson Transfer Station. This was not in the budget this year. Chairman Chandler will be checking with Jackson Selectmen to see if this can be purchased from the joint account and we can reimburse the account next year.

Selectman Vincent made a motion at 5:06 p.m. to enter nonpublic session for discussion of personnel items per NH RSA 91-A:3 II (b). Selectman Garland seconded the motion.

Roll call vote GGC – yes, VLG - yes, ADV – yes.

Selectman Garland made a motion at 5:57 p.m. to end the nonpublic session. Selectman Vincent seconded the motion.
